Change Screen Presentation in Java Workflows

Instructions for changing Java Workflows Themes and for moving from Themes to the Java Classic view and back again to Themes.


Java Themes display with all the toolbar functions at the top of the screen so it is easy to move from one function to another.

In the Themes view, wizards of the selected toolbar display down the left side of the window beginning with Common Tasks as shown below.




In the Themes view it is possible to resize the wizards bar on the left to make it smaller or larger. Place the cursor on the solid vertical line separating these wizards from the rest of the screen. Your cursor will become a double arrow (shown above) which will allow you to drag the wizards bar to the left to decrease its size or to the right to increase its size. By increasing the size of this wizard bar, you will be able to see more of the wizards' names (i.e.: all of "Call Number and Item Maintenance" will display), but you will also lose some of the blank portion of the screen that will become the search window.

1. To change the Themes view of Java Workflows, click on Preference > Desktop > Desktop Setup to access the window that provides the options that will make this setup change possible.



2. Shown below is the configuration window that will display. You may specify a default Help topic from the drop down menu next to that option. You may also specify an Opening Wizard by selecting one from the drop down menu next to that option. The selected wizard will open automatically when you log in to Java Workflows. ****Note that once you've selected an Opening Wizard, that selection no longer displays in the configuration screen.**


The current Themes selection in the example below is WINTER. Use the drop down menu next to that option to make a different Themes selection.



Selecting a different Theme will change the color presentation of Java Workflows. This change occurs immediately after clicking the OK button.


3. ****Multiple windows mode should be checked.** This option allows you to open multiple windows without having to close any windows first. If this option is selected you will be able to tile windows so that you can view more than one window at a time.

In the example below, the Theme has been changed to SPRING.




Another option for screen presentation is to select the Classic view.

4. Select Classic from the drop down menu next to Themes.



****Note:** If you set an Opening Wizard in Themes view, you will have to reset it if you switch to the Classic view. If you switch back to a Themes view, the Opening Wizard will have to be reset again.



When you select Classic view, help options appear at the bottom of the window.

5. Check the option for Display balloon help and any of the others you wish to activate. Click OK.
6. ****You must log out and back into Workflows to activate this change to the Classic view.**

Classic View of Workflows in the Java Client

In the Classic view of Workflows, the wizards do not occupy space along the left side of the screen so you have the entire screen in which to work.




Above is the Classic view of a customized toolbar. (**See Technote on Creating a Customized Toolbar for instructions.) It includes wizards for cataloging, serials, acquisitions, and circulation.

By creating a customized toolbar it is not necessary to right click at the end of the toolbar to select a different toolbar to move from one set of tasks to another.


The description of each wizard's function is provided only in the balloon help you see when the cursor is on the wizard.

If you don't wish to create a customized toolbar, right click at the end of the toolbar and click on the option to select current toolbar.

This results in a drop down menu from which you can select the toolbar you wish to use.




Because wizards are normally shown at the top of the screen, it is possible to use the entire screen in which to open multiple windows. These windows can be resized easily and the windows will retain the new size each time you open them.



Change View from Classic to Themes in Java Workflows

To change to the Themes view of Java Workflows, click on Preference > Desktop > Desktop Setup to access the window that provides the options that will make this setup change possible.



From the drop down menu, highlight the Themes view you wish to use. Click OK.

****Note:** Changing from the Classic view to Themes requires that you logout of Workflows and back in before your new view option will be activated.
