

## Cataloging Committee Report – June 2026

The Cataloging Committee, formerly known as the Online Quality Committee, consists of seven members, with one representative from each region, along with Stephanie Gertken serving as the Wyoming State Library representative. The following items were addressed during the past year:

### Committee housekeeping decisions:

- The committee officially changed its name from the Online Quality Committee to the Cataloging Committee.
- The committee reviewed and reorganized the WYLD Cataloging Standards and is finalizing a draft to submit for approval at the 2027 WYLD Annual Meeting.

### Cataloging decisions:

- Cataloging templates were created to help catalogers add records to the database more accurately and consistently. Templates are currently available for the following item types:
  - Books
  - Puzzles
  - Board games
  - Movies
  - Library of Things items
  - Kits
- Zoom trainings were offered on the use of cataloging templates.
- The committee decided to retain 655 fields with a second indicator of 0 (zero) in WYLD records.
- The committee decided that relationship designators should be added to subfield 4 in the 700 field (e.g., |eactor, |eillustrator, |etranslator, etc.)
- The committee decided that deluxe or limited editions should remain on the same bibliographic record as the regular print edition, with a note added in the 020 field to indicate the different edition. Catalogers may also use the public note field to add edition information such as “Deluxe Edition.”
- The committee decided that records for dyslexia-friendly books should include a 650 field to improve discoverability in the catalog.
  - Example: **650\_0 Dyslexia friendly books**
- The committee approved adding a local subject tracing for the Wyoming Budget Department.
  - Example: **110 1 |a Wyoming. |b Budget Department**
