WYLD Annual Business Meeting – Casper College, June 3rd, 2022

The WYLD Training Committee lost 2 members in March this year, Jill Mackey (retired), and Libby Ngo (moved to a different committee). Corrine Hundley became our new WYLD representative starting in February 2022 when Katie Rahman moved to the position of Systems Manager.

The committee continued reviewing and making changes to all of the skills checklists, reviewing and discussing each one, providing feedback and changes as needed. The skills checklists reviews were complete in January 2022.

In February, the committee discussed ways of simplifying training materials, and creating training videos or manuals for even the most basic of tasks (i.e. putting items on hold, billing users, etc.). We considered sending out a survey to the state libraries inquiring about training materials currently in use and needs for in-house training (i.e. videos).
