



Webcam Covers

*Simple – Cheap - Effective

Think of all the cameras in your life!

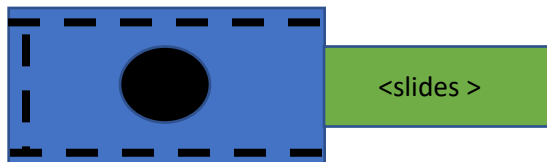
Amazon Echo, Google Home Hub, smart phones, tablets,
laptops, monitors, and of course web cameras purchased separately.

Webcam covers are an inexpensive way to ensure your privacy.

If you don't want to purchase a webcam cover, then consider a fun craft project!

Here's a webcam pattern you could use with a small piece of felt or fabric and a piece of paper.

1. Cut a piece of fabric or paper about the size of the blue box below. Note that it is best to see what fits your computer or phone first and measure that.
2. Cut a hole in the blue fabric or paper for the webcam to show through.
3. Affix the blue fabric/paper along the dotted lines to the monitor or device. Be sure to use adhesive that is nonpermanent and won't gum up your computer equipment.
4. Finally, cut a piece of paper that can slide in between the blue fabric and the webcam, stopping at the affixed end of the blue box.



Not crafty? Cover your webcam with a Post It Note like this.

Fold and place the sticky end on top the camera so you don't get adhesive on the camera lens.
