We are an international nonprofit working to close the gender gap in technology. We've sparked culture change through our campaigns and advocacy efforts, generating **13 billion** engagements globally. Of the **450,000** girls and young women we've reached through our programming and educational content, half are from historically underrepresented groups in tech. We have **90,000** college and post-college-aged alumni, which is almost **3X** the number of women who graduated with CS and related degrees in the US in 2019.

## OUR PHILOSOPHY: CODING, SISTERHOOD, BRAVERY

Our Clubs are about more than just coding. They're also about sisterhood and creating a culture of bravery—where students feel supported and encouraged to take risks and learn new skills.

## OUR CLUBS: FLEXIBLE, ENGAGING, CUSTOMIZABLE

Flexible curriculum featuring sisterhood activities, lessons about women in tech, self-guided coding tutorials for all skill levels in a variety of programming languages including Scratch, Python, HTML/CSS, JavaScript, and p5.js, and more!

A typical Club generally meets 1-2 hours for 10-15+ sessions during the year, but you'll have the flexibility to fully customize a schedule that works for you—whether you're meeting virtually or in-person.

We have Clubs as small as 3 members, to as big as 30+!
